


Charter

“...strive to achieve consensus on processes and positions through the development of white papers that will in turn assist in the development of policy and guidance that promotes munitions response program accomplishments...”




Charter (con't)

Roles and Responsibilities Matrix

- ▶ Attempts to avoid individual State RCRA UXO regulations
- ▶ Absent of regulatory authority argument
- ▶ Stresses “mutual agreement”
- ▶ Identifies areas where white papers are needed
